

Syncing with a Google Doc

In this tutorial, we will show you how to add data points to your project from a Google doc.

How to Do It

You can also upload data to iSENSE directly from a Google doc version of a spreadsheet. In your Google sheet, click on the blue “Share” link at the top right of the page and copy the given URL. Now, returning to the iSENSE website, when you click the “Google Doc” link under the “Contribute Data” heading, paste the URL you just copied and click “Save”. It should bring you to the same kind of page as uploading from a csv would, and you can proceed in the exactly same way as you would otherwise with a template.

Particular Advantages to this Method

If your Google doc is shared publicly (which you can do by going to the advanced share settings of your doc and changing who has access to your doc), other people can contribute data to your sheet, and this will in turn be synced with your project.
